- 2) <u>Storm drains</u> Tina suggested enlisting the help of high school Environmental club students to maintain storm drains near the school.
- 3) <u>Arts in the Park</u> Irene R. will ask the HS environmental club advisor, Jimmy Mokracek about participation in the event.
 - ACTION ITEM: We need more people to staff the table from 11:30 am to 4:30 pm. Please contact Irene R or Tina if you can help out.
- 4) <u>SJ Actions review</u> the goal is for SHP to form groups to review SJ actions to set priorities. For those who reviewed and/or met with their groups, the pertinent actions include:
 - water story
 - backyard composting-outreach on waste management
 - storm water management-including rain barrels, down spouts, adopt-a-drain
 - reduce food waste in supermarkets and schools, regional composting with digesters
 - mitigate extreme heat-does our borough have cooling centers? How to get the word out?
 - Climate change action plan & Sustainability Plan
 - impervious covering including parking lots and asphalt that create heat islands-how to mitigate
